Marjorie Jones (Maggie, Marge) as many know her, was born Maggie Marjorie Williams in Scotlandville, (Baton Rouge Parish), Louisiana on May 7, 1930; to the union of Reverend James Williams and Mattiell Davis. She was the fourth born of ten siblings; each of whom preceded her in death.

In 1950 she was united in marriage to Preston Jones; and to this union four children were born: Jacquelyn (Jackie, who preceded her in death), Karen (Robin, preceded her in death), Sherlyn (Sherry) and Russell (Rusty). Preston also preceded her in death.
